Those names in **RED** have either received FIFA bans and/or criminal indictments.

The names in YELLOW are FIFA officials who have similarly fallen foul of various authorities, but weren't part of the infamous Class of 2010.

Those who remain in **BLACK** have neither had an investigation or anything to marr their name, while the **BROWN** names, although not convicted of any wrongdoing, have had allegations and investigations surround them.

The **BLUE** names have been key players in FIFA's organisation and corruption probes, without any marks against themselves.
